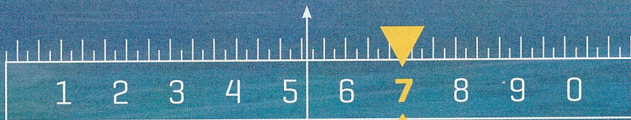

Flying or chartering a private aircraft can bring you to otherwise inaccessible escapes, from private tropical islands to rugged wilderness ranches. The following seven North American destinations may be hard to reach, but they're well worth the trip.

Staniel Cay

BAHAMAS

A serene tropical escape.

The 120-mile-long Exuma chain in the Bahamas' Out Islands is farther from the mainland than the western islands and has fewer tourists. On one small island in the middle of the chain, among secluded coves, white-sand beaches and turquoise waters, the Staniel Cay Yacht

Club can be accessed via a 3,000-foot airstrip. Visitors can book scuba and fishing charters or even pet human-savvy nurse sharks that swim around the pier. The Thunderball Grotto, a location for James Bond films *Thunderball* and *Never Say Never Again*, is a one-minute boat ride away. Snorkelers swim into the large cavern where shafts of light stream through holes above, illuminating the interior with a blue-green hue that reflects off limestone walls.
